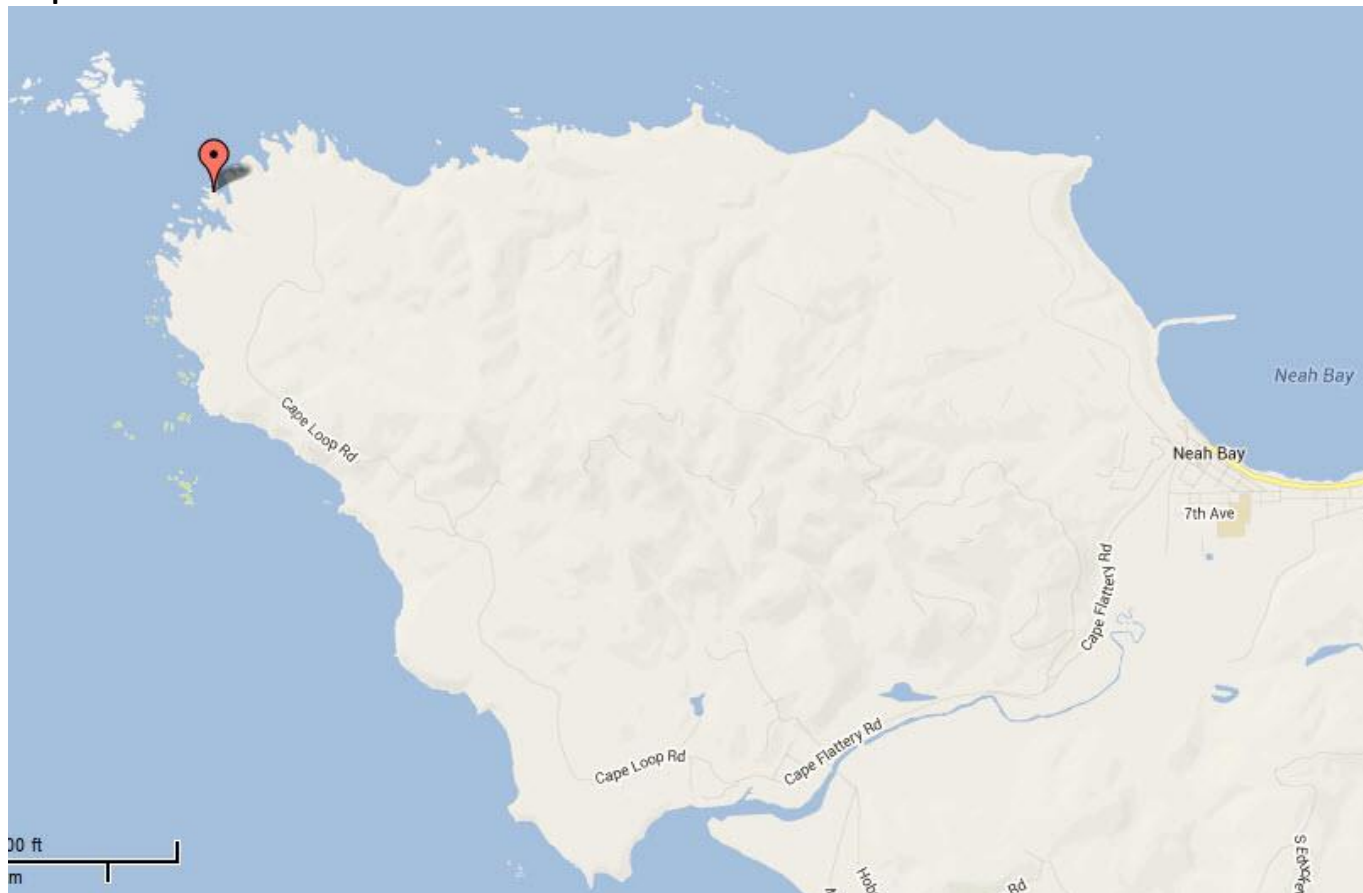
**GPS:** N48° 23.154, W124° 43.598

**Location:** From Port Angeles, follow US 101 west for 5 miles to the junction with State Route 112. Turn right (west) on SR 112, continuing for 64 miles to the community of Neah Bay. Just past the Makah Tribal Museum is Washburn's, where you can purchase the required recreation pass. Continue west on Bayview Avenue for 1 mile, following signs for "Cape Flattery and Beaches". Turn left on Fort Street, and in 0.1 mile turn right on 3rd Street. In another 0.1 mile turn left on Cape Flattery Road. In 2.5 miles pass the Tribal Center. Proceed for another 5.1 miles to the trailhead.

**Access:** There is ample parking at the trailhead, although this is a popular site and may fill up in summer. Accessing the site requires walking a trail for approx. 0.75 miles to reach the observation platform.

**Notes:** Northwest Forest Pass required. You can buy passes at National Forest offices and [online](#).
