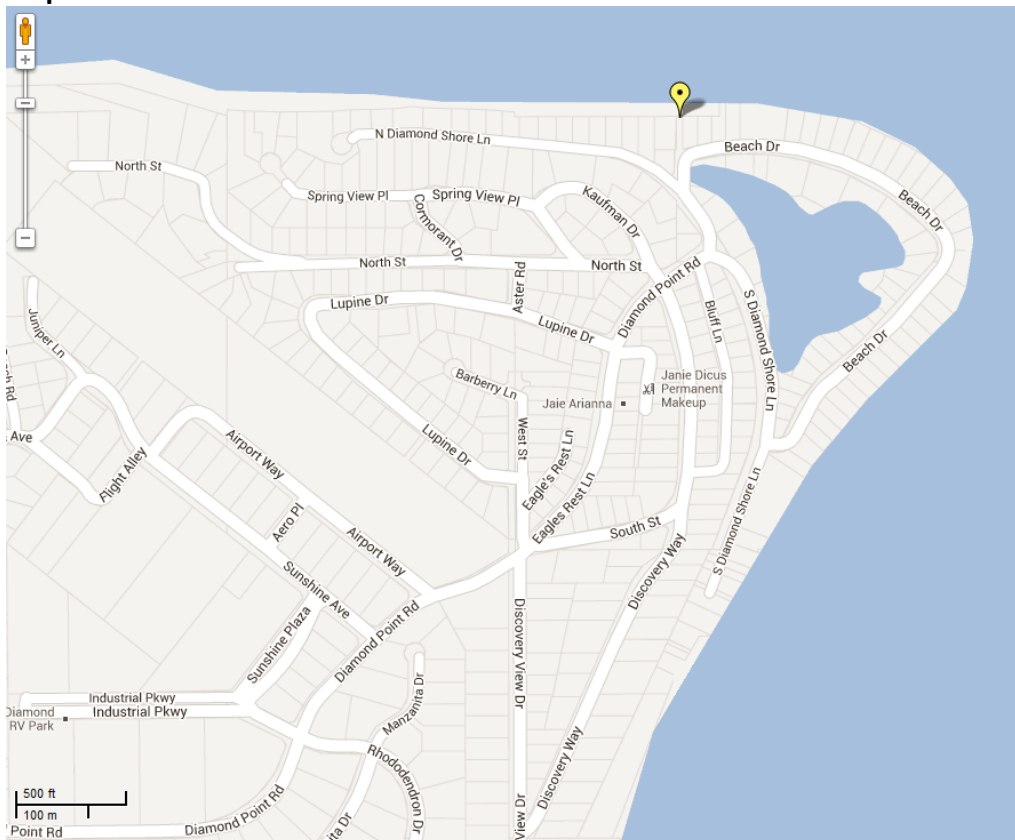

Location: Diamond Point. From Sequim, take Hwy 101 towards Olympia for approx. 8 miles, turn left onto Diamond Point Rd, turn left to stay on Diamond Point Rd, slight right to stay on Diamond Point Rd. Turn left onto N Diamond Shore Lane and then a slight right onto Beach Dr. Continue to 121 Beach Drive where you'll find a small parking space provided by the owner. There is a sign next to the parking spot that reads, "Seabird Watch Birders Welcome". The survey site is located at the end of the access road off of Beach Drive that leads to the boat launch.

Access: This area is publicly accessible at all times however, parking is limited. When possible, use the space provided by Ed Chrisman (spelling?) at 121 Beach Drive. I spoke with him about the project and he's happy to accommodate bird surveyors who may use the small gazebo in his yard during inclement weather if desired!

Notes: An access/parking permit is not required for this site. Conduct the survey (locate the tripod) at the end of the boat launch nearest the beach, where the ramp meets the sand, directly next to the "Toxic Shellfish" sign on the right side of the ramp.
