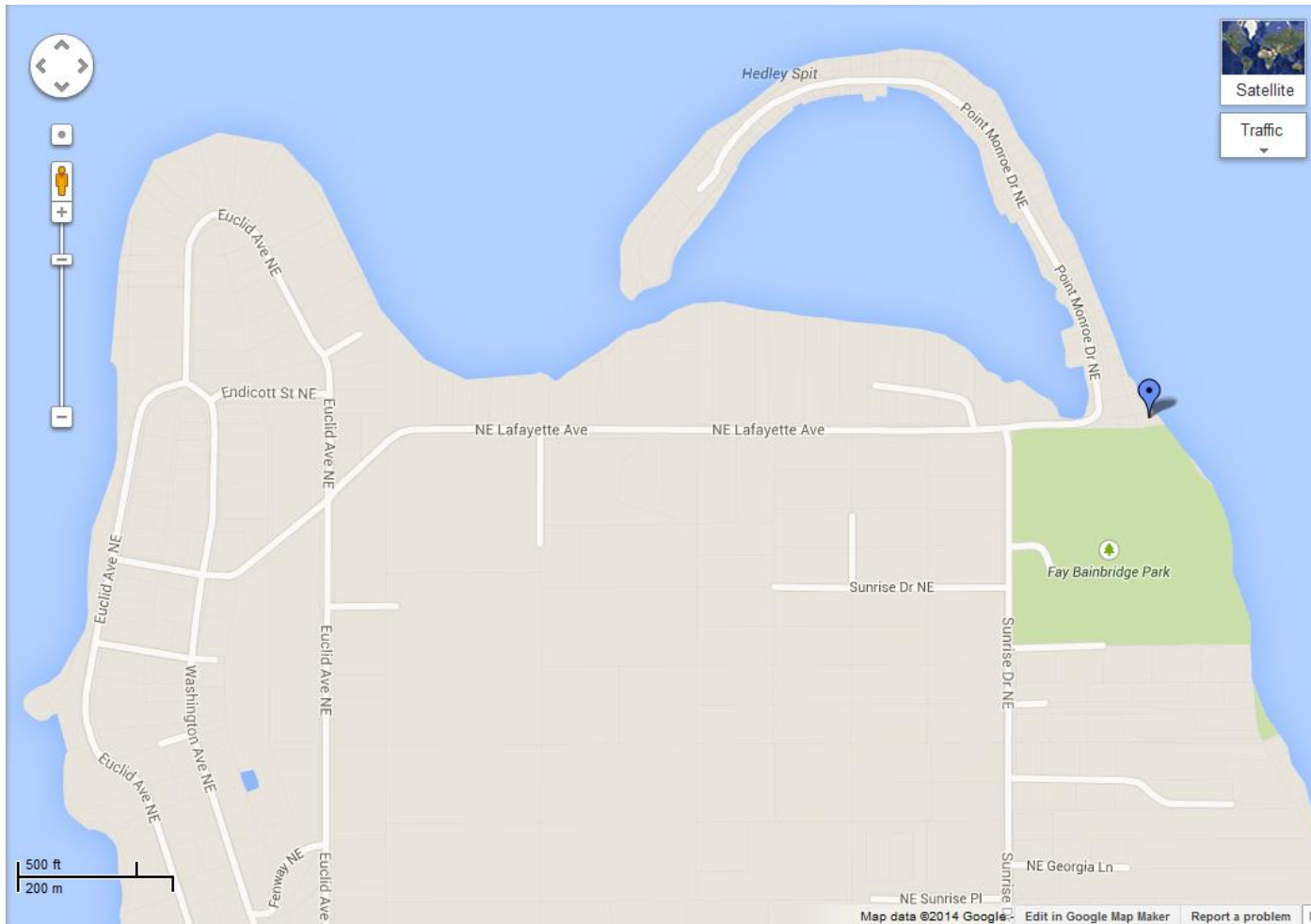
**Site Name:** Fay Bainbridge

**Location:** This survey location is situated on the beach at Fay Bainbridge Park. From Bainbridge town, take WA 305 N for 2.6 miles, turn right onto Phelps Rd NE, continue onto Washington Ave NE, turn right onto Euclid Ave NE, slight right onto NE Lafayette Ave, continue straight onto Point Monroe Dr NE and Fay Bainbridge Park will be on your left. Park in the large parking lot and walk to the beach using the footpath at the northern end of the parking lot. As you walk towards the water you will encounter many driftwood logs, locate the logs that form the configuration detailed in the images below and conduct the survey (locate the tripod) as best you can.

**Access:** There should be sufficient space in the parking lot.
